**A RESOLUTION OF LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP
MODIFYING THE SCHEDULE OF REIMBURSEMENT COSTS
RELATED TO THE REIMBURSEMENT FOR COSTS INCURRED
BY FIRE DEPARTMENTS OR EMS SERVICES OPERATING
WITHIN LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP FOR HAZARDOUS
ABATEMENT INCIDENTS, ENVIRONMENTAL INCIDENTS,
AND FIRE SAFETY AND RESCUE RESPONSES ORIGINALLY
AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE NO. 619.**

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2015, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Providence Township (the “Township”), pursuant to authority to regulate fire services and emergency services located within the Township granted by the Second-Class Township Code 53 P.S. §66803(b), adopted Ordinance No. 619, ordaining that Fire Departments and EMS services operating within the Township may seek reimbursement for the reasonable costs of responding to hazardous abatement incidents, environmental incidents, and fire safety and rescue responses; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 619 approved a schedule for reimbursement costs, which schedule was to be modified from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Lower Providence Fire Department has submitted a schedule of reimbursement costs intended to modify the original.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Township of Lower Providence as follows:

ARTICLE I.

The Township adopts the reimbursement costs set forth on the billing schedule attached hereto as “Exhibit A” for purposes of reimbursing Fire Departments or EMS Services operating in the Township pursuant to Ordinance No. 619.

ARTICLE II. SEVERABILITY

If any section, clause, provision, or portion of this resolution shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this resolution.

ARTICLE III. REPEALER

Any resolution or any part of any resolution previously passed by the Township which conflicts with this resolution is hereby repealed insofar as the same is specifically inconsistent with this resolution.

ARTICLE IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This resolution shall be effective on the date of adoption.


